



Mount Maunganui Intermediate School

ENROLMENT SCHEME

January 2016

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below [and shown on the attached map and description] shall be entitled to enrol at the school. ***Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.***

Start on the shoreline adjacent to the intersection of Papamoa Beach Road and Palm Beach Boulevard.

The boundary tracks along Palm Beach Boulevard, to the intersection with Oriental Parade and St Heliers Place, to include all addresses on the western side of Palm Beach Boulevard and excluding all addresses on the latter two streets.

From the south end of Palm Beach Boulevard, the boundary runs south-west towards Kairua Road, east of 1127 State Highway 2 [included] and 1189 State Highway 2 [not included]. The boundary then turns west and runs above Kairua Road [not included] to Rangataua Bay.

The boundary then follows the shoreline, pasting Tauranga Airport, intersecting State Highway 2 at Tauranga Bridge, tracking around the Mount and back down to east coast to the starting point adjacent to 432 Papamoa Beach Road.

All addresses on either side of all roads included within this boundary will be entitled to enrol at Mt Maunganui Intermediate School.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

As per the enrolment scheme legislation, applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

Note: Special Programme

This category specified as first priority in the Education Act 1989 is not applicable at Mount Maunganui Intermediate because the school does not run a Special Programme approved by the Secretary of Education.

Therefore the following priority order applies for out of zone enrolments:

- First Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of current students
- Second Priority will be given to applicants who are siblings of former students
- Third Priority will be given to applicants who are children of former students of the school
- Fourth Priority will be given to applicants who are either children of board employees or children of board members
- Fifth Priority will be given to all other out of zone applicants

If there are more applicants in the first, second, third, fourth or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking first and second priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
