Teacher Only Day & New MOE Reporting Guidelines

Last Friday, our school was closed for a Teacher Only Day. This was a highly valuable opportunity for our staff to come together and undergo professional development regarding the Ministry of Education's new nationwide assessment and reporting requirements.



As part of the refreshed New Zealand Curriculum, the Ministry of Education is shifting all schools towards a consistent reporting framework. This means that instead of the old "curriculum levels," student progress in Reading, Writing, and Maths will now be reported using five standard nationwide **Progress Descriptors** (*Emerging, Developing, Consolidating, Proficient and Exceeding*).

Our staff spent the day aligning our regular classroom evidence and recent SMART assessment data with these new guidelines. When your child's completed report is shared with you via the **HERO app**, you will see:

- A clear Progress Descriptor for Reading, Writing and Maths
- A teacher narrative explaining the results
- Next learning steps, along with practical tips on how you can support your child's learning at home

Please make sure you book a time to meet with your child's classroom teacher for our upcoming parent - teacher interviews in week 11, (link to book will come out soon).

A strong partnership between home and school is important for your child's learning journey, and these interviews are a fantastic opportunity to discuss these new report formats, celebrate growth, and look at next steps together.

Looking Ahead: Japan Sister School Trip

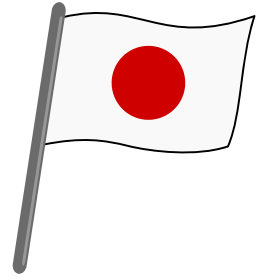
We are very excited to be continuing our wonderful relationship with our sister school in Japan!

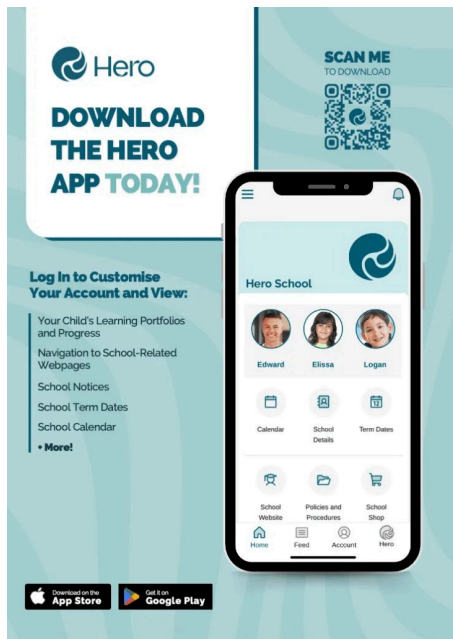
Hero is a secure, all-in-one platform designed to simplify school communication and bring your child's learning journey to life.

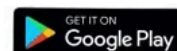

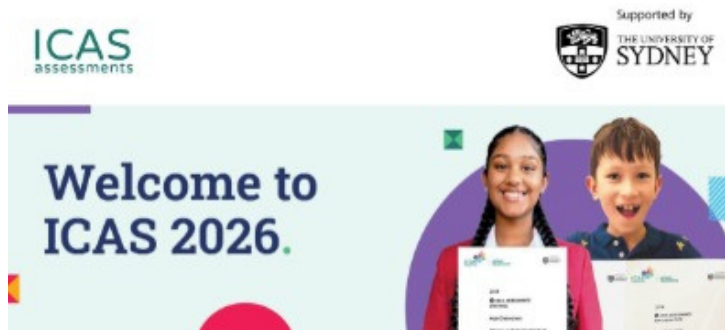

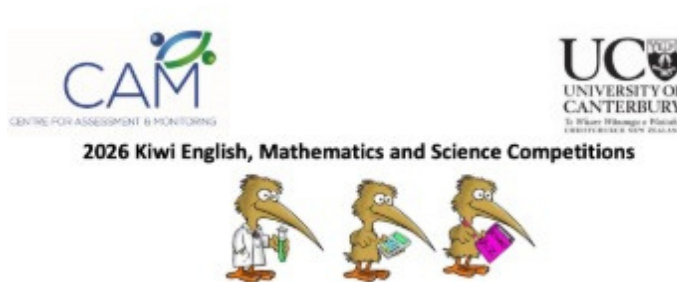

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

With AIMS fast approaching, we would like to share some important information and reminders.

Registrations Closed

All AIMS registrations have now closed. Participation costs will be charged to your school account and are required to be paid by **21 August**.

If your child withdraws from AIMS from this point onwards, a refund can only be issued if a replacement participant can be found. Unfortunately, AIMS does not provide refunds once entries have been submitted.

Opening Ceremony

The cost of your child's Opening Ceremony ticket is included in the AIMS fees paid to the school. Tickets will be distributed through your Teacher in Charge (TIC) during the week prior to AIMS.

Arrival Time: 6:20pm on Sunday (meet at designated area as advised by TIC). **Teams:** MMI students will be grouped together.

Parents, coaches, managers and supporters wishing to attend the Opening Ceremony will need to purchase their own tickets. Ticket sales open on **Monday 3 August**. Please note that tickets sold out very quickly in 2025, so we encourage you to purchase early if you wish to attend.

All Mount Maunganui Intermediate students will be attending the **7.00pm** show. The Green Team may attend the afternoon session - This is yet to be confirmed.

Training Expectations

Attendance at all trainings is expected. If a student is injured, we encourage them to continue attending training where possible so they can remain involved with the team and stay informed.

If your child is unwell, please keep them home and notify the coach or manager. This helps keep everyone healthy leading into the tournament.
